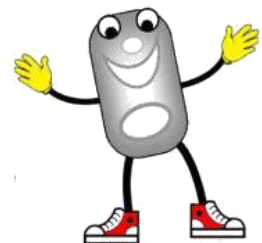


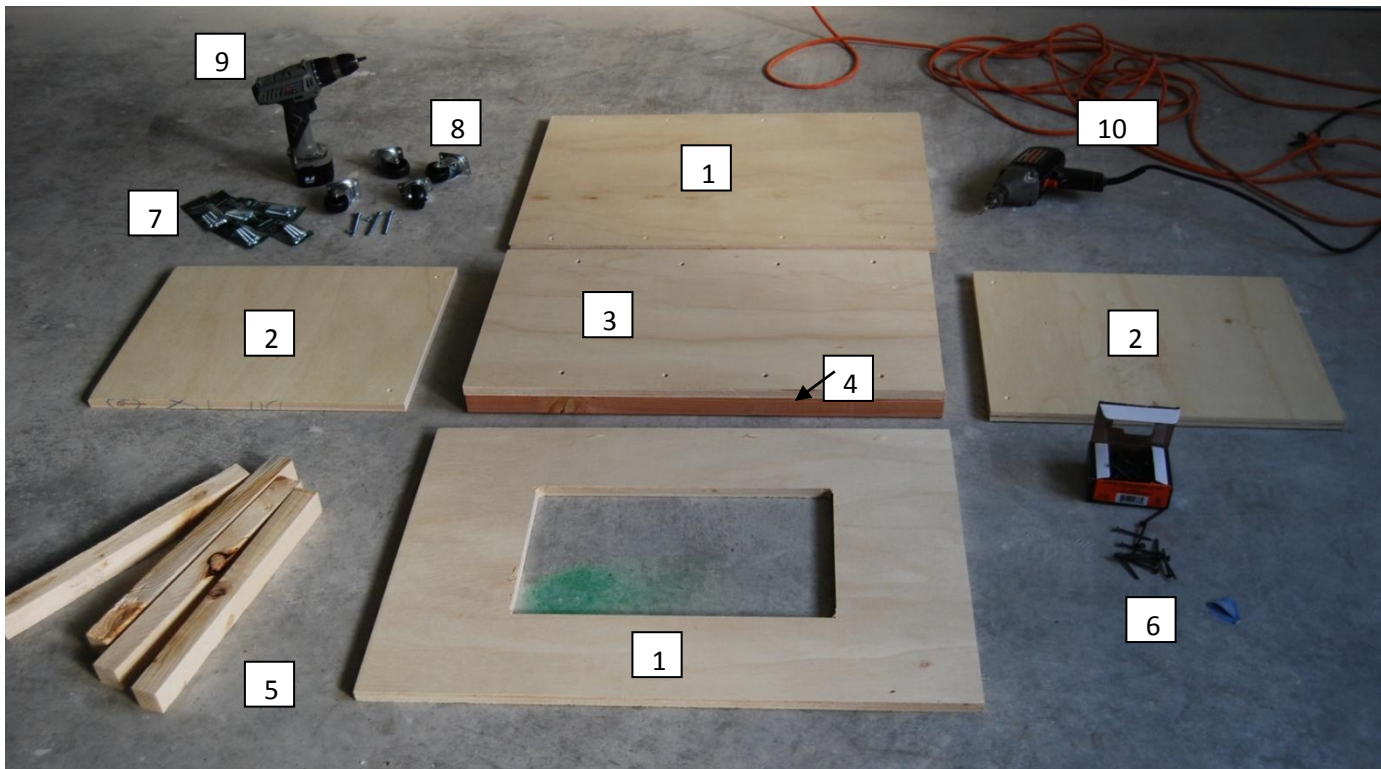
Wooden Collection House (top opening)

Follow these simple instructions to build your own tab house for your school or office!





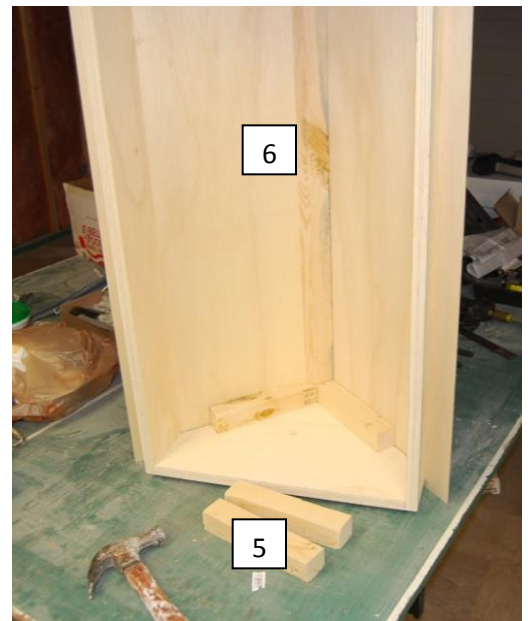
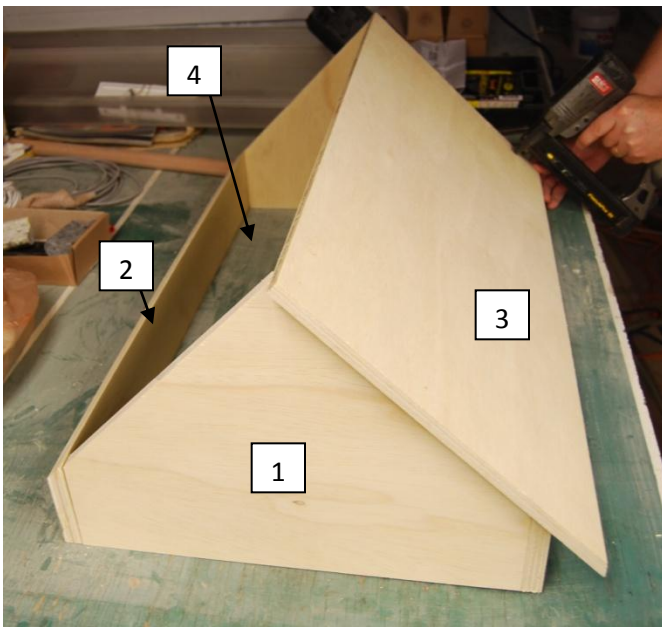
Building the main box

Material

<u>Material</u>	<u>Quantity</u>
1. 31 x 21 in. piece of plywood	2
2. 16 x 21 in. piece of plywood	2
3. 31 x 16 in. piece of plywood	1
4. 31 in. long 2 x 4	2
5. 15 in. 2 x 2	4
6. Coarse thread drywall screws 2"	1 pack
7. Machine screws: round head combo ¼" – 20 x 3"	16 screws
8. 150 lb. strength caster	4
9. Screwdriver	1
10. Drill	

Directions

- Build base by using 2" Coarse Thread Drywall Screws, screw in two 31" 2 x 4's into each side of the 31 x 16.
- Cut an 18 x 13 window in one of the 31 x 21 boards.
- Screw in all 4 sides to the base using the 2" Coarse Thread Drywall Screws. (Pre-drill the holes).
- Drill in the holes where your casters will go then screw in Casters to bottom of base using Machine Screws: Round Head Combo ¼" – 20 x 3", tighten bolts on the inside of the box.
- Screw in 2 x 2 for support in all 4 corners using same drywall screws to screw in sides and base.



Building the roof

Materials

1. 16 in. base, 4 in. sides, with a height of 12 in.
2. 31 x 4 in. piece of plywood
3. 33 x 16 in. piece of plywood
4. 33 x 15.5 in piece of plywood.
5. 2 x 2 in. 3 inches in length
6. 2 x 2 in. 18 inches in length

Directions

- A. Tack the 4 x 31 pieces of wood to the two base pieces. This created the base of the roof.
- B. Tack the shorter roof piece to the base, then nail the longer roof piece to base so that they fit together.
- C. Flip the roof onto its side looking in.
- D. Nail a 2 x 2, 18 in. in length, in the middle to brace the roof.
- E. Nail a 2 x 2, 3 in. in length, piece in all four corners to help brace the roof.
- F. Use a Jigsaw to cut a 12 x 8 in hole in one of the roof sides.
- G. Go back and nail all the pieces together to secure the roof.

Painting

Once completed, remember to prime the whole box before you paint. We painted ours white with a black roof and red accents, but you can choose your own colors. (It's a good idea to paint the inside, too, just for that extra touch.)
