Some examples might be cleaned milk jugs, coffee or Pringles cans, Ziploc bags, boxes or plastic containers. Use your artistic talents to decorate your containers any way you like. Cardboard tab "houses" are also available for pickup from Cincinnati's Ronald McDonald House.
